Composition

Each ampoule contains:

Active ingredient: Pheniramine hydrogenn maleate 45.5mg / 2ml

Inactive ingredients: Water for injection

Properties

- Avil injection solution is suitable for the treatment of severe hypersensitivity reactions and pruritus of varying origin.
- It reduces secretion in catarrhal disorders and weeping eczema.

Indications

Allergic conditions (hypersensitivity reactions) such as:

- Hay fever (pollinosis) with attacks of sneezing, itching, running nose, and conjunctivitis.
- Urticaria with pruritus, redness, wealing, and swelling of the skin.
- Eczema of nervous origin (neurodermatitis) with pruritus.

Contraindications

- Hypersensitivity to pheniramine.
- Prostatic hypertrophy with residual urine formation.

Pregnancy & lactation

No available studies for use in pregnancy and lactation. Avil should be used only if strictly indicated, and after considering the benefit/risk ratio for mother and child.

Adverse reactions

- Occasionally there may be drowsiness, gastrointestinal complaints, dryness of mouth, palpitation, urinary retention or hypersensitivity reactions.
- In isolated cases, higher dosage may produce hallucinations, restlessness or confusion; in small children, agitation.
- In patients with narrow-angle glaucoma, a rise in intra-ocular pressure is possible, which makes ophthalmologic control necessary.
- Even if used according to prescription, this preparation may reduce alertness to such an extent that the ability to cope with street traffic or operate machinery is impaired.

Interactions

- The effect of drugs which act on the central nervous system, e.g. tranquillizers, hypnotics and MAO inhibitors, may be potentiated.
- The effect of alcohol may be potentiated.
